Mr. Speaker welcomed to the Assembly Vermont Senator William T. Doyle, past Co-Chair of the Council of State Governments Eastern Regional Conference and Mr. Alan Sokolow, Council Director.		
During Introduction of Guests and Congratulatory Messages, Hon. Mr. Green rose on a point of order, namely, that the congratulatory statement made by Mr. Richard, the Member for Shediac—Cap-Pelé, fell outside the guidelines of messages or statements of congratulation and was therefore out of order.
