Prayers.

Hon. Mr. Green laid upon the table of the House a document entitled *Electronic Transactions Legislation, Legislative Services Branch, December 2000.* 

Ms. Weir gave Notice of Motion 37 that on Thursday, December 21, 2000, she would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr.?Richard:

That an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House by the Minister of Justice, all letters, memos, faxes, electronic mail or any other correspondence sent by or forwarded by the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court of New Brunswick to the Minister of Justice between September 15 and December 8, 2000, in relation to the court stenographers' strike.
