Mr. Richard paid tribute to the memory of George Harrison, former member of the Beatles, recently deceased.

Ms. Weir gave Notice of Motion 43 that on Thursday, December 6, 2001, she would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. S. Graham:

That an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House by the Minister of Business New Brunswick, Minister of Finance and the Minister of Natural Resources, any correspondence (including electronic), memos, reports, reviews, or any other document from the Executive Director of Assessments of Service New Brunswick, or any other employee, related to the Heavy Industry Accelerated Project.

Hon. Mr. Green announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole to consider legislation; namely, Bills 2 and 3.

The House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole with Mr. Ashfield in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair and Mr. Ashfield, the Chairman, after requesting Mr. Speaker revert to the Order of Presentations of Committee Reports, reported:

That the Committee had directed him to report the following Bills as agreed to:

Bill 2, *An Act to Amend the Occupational Health and Safety Act.*

Bill 3, *An Act to Amend the Workers' Compensation Act.*

And the Committee asked leave to make a further report.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then, 12.40 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
