Hon. Mr. Lord laid upon the table of the house a letter dated November 22, 2001, to the Rt. Hon. Jean Crétien, Prime Minister of Canada from Hon. Bernard Lord, Premier of New Brunswick.

Following Oral Questions, Mr. Speaker requested that all Members strive to ensure that question period is conducted properly by showing the courtesy normally afforded the Speaker, facing the chair when speaking, directing all questions and answers through the chair and avoiding lengthy questions and answers.
