Prayers.

Ms. Blaney, Member for Rothesay, laid upon the table of the House, a petition in opposition to the practice of "double breasting" and in support of Bill 60, *An Act to Amend the Industrial Relations Act*. (Petition 42)

---

On motion of Hon. Mr. Jamieson, seconded by Hon. V. Boudreau: RESOLVED, That when the Assembly adjourns at the end of this sitting day, it stand adjourned until Thursday, June 7, 2007, at 2 o'clock p.m.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, announced that following third reading, it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole to consider Bills 64, 66, 69, 73, 72, 73, 74, and 75.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson announced that it was the intention of government that Bill 32, *Franchises Act*, be read a second time tomorrow.

The following Bill was read a third time:

Bill 78, *An Act to Amend the Land Titles Act*.

Ordered that the said Bill does pass.

The House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole with Mr. R. Boudreau in the chair.

At 12.30 o'clock p.m., the Chairman left the chair, to resume again at 2 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Mr. R. Boudreau in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Kenny took the chair.

And after some further time, due to the unavoidable absence of Mr. Speaker, Mr. R. Boudreau, the Deputy Speaker, resumed the chair as Acting Speaker and Mr. Kenny, the Chairman, after requesting that Mr. Deputy Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported:

That the Committee had directed him to report the following Bills as agreed to:

Bill 64, *An Act Respecting the Members' Pension Act and the Members' Superannuation Act.*

Bill 66, *An Act to Amend the Pension Benefits Act.*

Bill 69, *An Act to Repeal the Quieting of Titles Act.*

And that the Committee had directed him to report progress on the following Bill:

Bill 23, *An Act to Amend the Members' Conflict of Interest Act.*

And the Committee asked leave to make a further report.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Deputy Speaker put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then, 6 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
