Mr. Mockler welcomed to the House Mr. Burt Paulin, Liberal Member of the Legislative Assembly for Restigouche West (2003-2006).

Mr. Northrup, Member for Kings East, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of the residents of Markhamville and Hammondvale urging the government to upgrade the road between Jeffries Corner and Markhamville. (Petition 5)

Hon. Mr. Murphy, the Government House Leader, gave notice that on Friday, March 14, 2008, it was the intention of government to resume the adjourned debate on the amendment to the motion that Bill 34 be now read a second time and that Bills 35, 36, 26, 27, 30, 31 and 32 be called for second reading.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 17, *An Act to Amend the Assessment Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, due to the unavoidable absence of Mr. Speaker, Mr. Kenny, the Deputy Speaker, took the chair as Acting Speaker.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 23, *Heritage Hunting*, *Fishing and Trapping Act*, a debate arose thereon.
