Mr. Fraser, Member for Miramichi-Bay du Vin, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of concerned citizens of Miramichi urging the government to build a new K-5 elementary school to replace the loss of the schools in their community. (Petition 12)

Following Oral Questions, Hon. P. Robichaud rose on a point of order and submitted that Mr. Doucet had questioned the honesty of the Premier and the Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure. Mr. Doucet withdrew the remarks.

The following Bills were introduced and read a first time.

Bill 22, *An Act to Amend the Public Interest Disclosure Act.*

By Hon. Ms. Blais,

Bill 23, *An Act Respecting Provincial Court Judges' Pensions.*

Hon. P. Robichaud, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to consider the estimates of the Department of Wellness, Culture and Sport and the Department of Tourism and Parks.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee of Supply with Mr. Urquhart in the chair.

At 4.55 o'clock p.m., Mr. Urquhart declared a recess and left the chair.

The Committee resumed with Mr. Urquhart in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair, and Mr. Urquhart, the Chair, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported that the Committee had had under consideration the matters referred to them, had made some progress therein, had passed several items, and asked leave to sit again.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker then put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

MAIN ESTIMATES, 2011 - 2012

ORDINARY ACCOUNT

DEPARTMENT OF WELLNESS, CULTURE AND SPORT

Resolved, That there be granted to Her Majesty a sum not exceeding \$19,039,000 to defray the expenses of the following programs for the fiscal year ending the 31st of March, 2012:

Management	414,000
Culture	10,046,000
Wellness, Sport and Community Development.....	8,632,000
Less amounts authorized by law.....	53,000
Voted	19,039,000

The said items were concurred in by the House.
