Message from the Chief Electoral Officer

Report on the 2024 and 2025 Local Government By-elections

Three sets of local government by-elections were held in 2024 and 2025 to fill vacancies on various councils. I am pleased to present this report with the results from the three events.

May 6, 2024

By-elections were scheduled for Monday, May 6, 2024, to fill 11 vacancies in eight local governments.

At the close of nominations, on Friday, April 12, 2024, there were enough candidates to hold elections for the following five positions in four communities:

District of Carleton North	1 Councillor, Ward 4
Grand Lake	1 Councillor, Ward 2
Île-de-Lamèque	1 Councillor, Ward 3
Île-de-Lamèque	1 Councillor, Ward 5
Lakeland Ridges	Mayor

Candidates were elected by acclamation in the following positions in three communities:

Arcadia	1 Councillor, Ward 3
Nackawic-Millville	1 Councillor, Ward 5
Lakeland Ridges	1 Councillor, Ward 4

Vacancies remained for the following positions in three communities:

Campobello Island	1 Councillor, Ward 2
Lakeland Ridge	1 Councillor, Ward 4
Tracy	1 Councillor at Large

Those vacancies would be included in the next round of by-elections scheduled for December 2024.

The total number of eligible electors for these byelections after revisions were completed was 6,843. In total, 2,073 votes were cast in these local government elections, which represents a voter turnout of 30.29%.

The direct cost of these by-election was \$278,175.

December 9, 2024

By-elections were scheduled for Monday, December 9, 2024, to fill 16 vacancies in 16 local governments. Two of the vacancies were created following the October 21 provincial general election when councillors in Hautes-Terres and Saint John (Ward 3) were elected as members of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick.

Elections New Brunswick booked social media ads on Facebook and Instagram geotargeted to those local governments with vacancies encouraging people to consider running as a candidate. At the close of nominations, on Friday, November 15, 2024, there were enough candidates to hold elections for the following five positions in four communities:

On the day nominations closed for the by-elections, Canada Post was the subject of strike action by postal workers, bringing Canada Post delivery services to a halt. During the week of November 25, 2024, voter information cards were scheduled to be sent to electors in the ten communities having by-elections. The decision was made to proceed with the printing of the voter information cards in the event the strike was settled in time for our vendor to provide them to Canada Post for delivery prior to election day. In the meantime, Elections New Brunswick booked radio ads and social media posts targeting people in those communities holding by-elections encouraging them to look up their voting places using our website, or by calling a temporary call centre opened to answer calls from electors. In the end, the Canada Post strike continued beyond the event and the voter information cards were never sent and eventually shredded.

Recount

The contest in Valley Waters, Ward 4, ended with a 20-vote difference between the winner and the individual who placed second. A recount requested by the runner-up did not result in a change from the results that were reported on election night.

The total number of eligible electors for these byelections after revisions were completed was 36,020. In total, 5,680 votes were cast in these ten local government elections, which represents a voter turnout of 15.77%.

The direct cost of these by-election was \$544,756.

April 14, 2025

By-elections were scheduled for Monday, April 14, 2025, to fill 15 vacancies on 11 local governments.

Elections New Brunswick booked social media ads on Facebook and Instagram geotargeted to those local governments with vacancies encouraging people to consider running as a candidate. At the close of nominations, on Friday, March 21, 2025, there were enough candidates to hold elections for the following eight positions in seven communities:


The total number of eligible electors for these byelections after revisions were completed was 33,432. In total, 9,694 votes were cast in these ten local government elections, which represents a voter turnout of 29%.

The direct cost of these by-election was \$498,504.

These are the last set of by-elections to be held before the province-wide local government elections scheduled for May 11, 2026. Under the *Local Governance Act*, a by-election cannot be held during the 12 months immediately preceding the date of a general election.
