Hon. Mr. Gauvin welcomed to the House Bertrand Cahuet, consul général de France dans les provinces Atlantiques. Mr. Savoie joined in this regard.

The following Bill was introduced and read a first time:

By Hon. Mr. Herron ,
Bill 45, *Mineral Resources Act*.

Mr. Savoie gave Notice of Motion 38 that on Thursday, May 28, 2026, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Ms. Scott-Wallace:

THAT an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House the agreement between the Government of New Brunswick and Agropur Cooperative where Opportunities New Brunswick is providing up to \$2.4 million in the form of a non-repayable contribution for Agropur Cooperative to support modernization of its Miramichi facility and the expansion of milk processing capacity.

Ms. M. Johnson, Opposition House Leader, gave notice that on Thursday, May 14, 2026, Opposition Members' Business would be considered in the following order: Motion 13, 35 and 37.

Mr. M. LeBlanc, Government House Leader, announced that following third reading, it was the intention of government that Bills 40, 41, 42, 43 and 44 be called for second reading until 3 p.m.; at which time the House would adjourn.

The following Bills were read a third time:

Bill 34, *An Act Respecting the Highway Act and the Salvage Dealers Licensing Act*.

Bill 36, *An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Act*.

Ordered that the said Bills do pass.

Debate resumed on the adjourned debate on the motion that Bill 40, *An Act Respecting Health Quality and Patient Safety*, be now read a second time.

At 12 p.m. the House recessed. At 1.06 p.m. the House resumed.

And after some time, Madam Speaker interrupted proceedings and announced that the hour of adjournment had arrived.

And then, 3 p.m., the House adjourned.
